



The Vienna Ring Tram

The Vienna Ring Boulevard is an Austrian World Heritage Site. The majestic road with its side alleys was laid out in the mid-19th century around the center of the city, replacing the old city walls. Ornate buildings such as the State Opera, parliament buildings, the City Hall, The Imperial Theatre and numerous palaces were erected along the Ring. All of these sights can be viewed from the Vienna Ring Tram, irrespective of the weather. Hop onboard and enjoy the tour in German, English, French, Italian, Spanish, Hungarian, Russian or Japanese. The audio guides in Viennese dialect and especially for children are also popular with German-speaking visitors.

The Vienna Giant Ferris Wheel

Located in Vienna's world-famous Prater entertainment park the ferris wheel has been turning since 1897 and has become a famous landmark in the Viennese skyline. During the ride you can enjoy breathtaking views of the city.

The Museum of Illusions is Austria's first museum dedicated to illusions and trick art. With its large collection of holograms, stereograms and optical illusions it creates moments of magic. The exhibition promises entertainment, interactivity and educational experiences for visitors of all ages. Unlike ordinary museums the concept of the Museum of Illusions is based on interaction with the visitors. For this purpose, participating and touching the exhibits is expressly desired. But be careful, the museum will flip your world upside down.

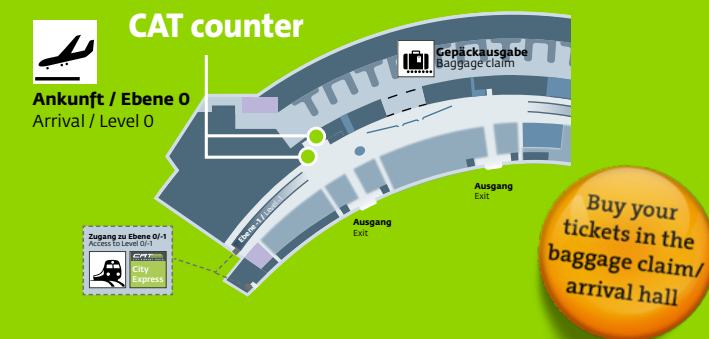

Where to buy the Stopover-tickets?

Do you have 4 hours or more to spend in Vienna? Why not take a trip to the city center and explore the city and some of its most famous sights? With the City Airport Train, you'll reach the center of Vienna within 16 minutes. You can choose between six attractive activities and use the security fast lane upon return to the airport! Your hand luggage can be stored at the Baggage Service Centers at the airport or at the CAT terminal in the city center.



The Stopover-tickets can be bought from the CAT sales staff in the baggage claim hall or at the CAT counter in the arrivals hall. We are also happy to assist you with any queries.

In Vienna, the CAT terminal is located at Wien Mitte The Mall, a shopping mall and public transport hub. There is also a staffed counter, should you have any questions about returning to the airport. You can also call the 24 hour CAT Hotline: +43 1 25 250.

① Station > Praterstern

Take the commuter train S at Wien Mitte to Praterstern (1 stop). Please plan at least four hours for this activity.

Hop on hop off bus:

② Station > Wien Mitte

Exit the shopping mall and turn right. The Hop on hop off bus stop is located opposite the Museum of Applied Arts (MAK) next to Wien Mitte station.

③ Station > Stephansplatz

Take the underground U3 to Stephansplatz (2 stops); 10 minutes.

The Imperial Treasury

④ Station > Herrengasse

Take the underground U3 to Herrengasse (3 stops); 15 minutes.

Museum of Illusions

⑤ Station > Herrengasse

Take the underground U3 to Herrengasse (3 stops); 15 minutes.

Vienna Ring Tram

⑥ Station > Schwedenplatz

Take the underground U4 at Wien Mitte to Schwedenplatz (1 stop); 5 minutes.



The Imperial Treasury: Discover valuable treasures from ancient times

The Imperial Treasury in Vienna is located in the oldest part of the Hofburg Palace. It is divided into the secular and the ecclesiastical collection. It houses the Crown of the Holy Roman Empire, the Austrian Imperial Crown and further Habsburg treasures of immeasurable value. Furthermore you can admire unique pieces of jewelry which once belonged to Habsburg archduchesses and empresses, including the Empress Elisabeth. Because of its extraordinary collection of imperial status symbols, the Imperial Treasury is one of the most important treasuries in the world.

Mozarthaus Vienna: Wander in the footsteps of Wolfgang Amadé Mozart

Visit the historic apartment which was Wolfgang Amadé Mozart's residence from 1784 to 1787. At Mozarthaus Vienna you can find the composer's only surviving Viennese apartment, where he composed more music than anywhere else. It presents information about the life and work of the musical genius with focus on the great composer's Vienna years, which represent the peak of his creative achievement. In addition to the main exhibition the Mozarthaus Vienna offers temporary exhibitions.
